Stop Minnesota From Taxing its Shoreline to Death

Dear [firstname],

Minnesota is taxing its natural resources to death.

A recent study by the US Forest Service found that more than 80 percent of families that own forest land want to preserve the land. In Minnesota, the number is 86 percent. Yet, since 2001, when property taxes on shoreline and forest habitat began to spike, the average size of a seasonal lot in Minnesota has shrunk from 78 acres to less than 53 acres. Simply put, high property taxes are forcing people to sell or subdivide land they would rather preserve. Once sold it is developed or redeveloped. This development is one of the main causes of lake and river degradation in the state.
